PAP Information

A student who has shown previous success in certain core subjects may consider taking higher level English, math, science, and/or social studies courses in order to prepare for AP courses in high school. PAP courses take the place of regular courses.

It is recommended that for the PAP subject(s) a student selects that he or she has previously passed the Reading/Math STAAR in that subject area and has maintained an average of at least 85% in his or her 6th grade class for that subject area. Students may be exited from a PAP course and placed into an on-level course if they are unsuccessful with PAP material (average below a 70).

All secondary (grades 7-12) identified G/T students will not be served through a pull-out program. G/T students will be served by differentiated curriculum that will be provided through both PAP and on-level classes.

Only two PAP courses can be guaranteed. Any more than two will be contingent upon scheduling needs. A parent signature is required for PAP enrollment.

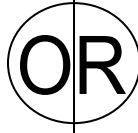

ELECTIVE COURSES

In addition to core classes, students will take a required elective consisting of one semester of Technology Applications and one semester of Exploring College and Careers. Students will also be required to choose athletics or PE and one additional elective.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION: Students must choose either athletics (which requires practice before school) or PE. If athletics is chosen, you must complete a separate Athletic Participation Packet that you will receive from your current campus AND attend the mandatory 3-day Evaluation in May.

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR INCOMING 7TH GRADE STUDENTS

According to Texas State law, all incoming 7th grade students are required to have current immunization records. Aledo Middle School follows State requirements; therefore, no student will be allowed to begin school, or receive a schedule, without documentation of all required immunizations. The newest required immunizations are as follows:

Tdap – required within 5 years of beginning 7th grade

Menactra (MCV/Meningitis) – one immunization required

Varicella #2 – second immunization required. If a student had the varicella illness (chicken pox), then documentation of illness may be substituted for the immunization.
